- **Growth over time:** in 1982, the figure was 1 in 108 adults^{1,2}
- Percent behind bars: at year end 2007, 39 percent of the correctional population was in prison or jail (national rank: 17); the figure for 1982 was 36 percent (national rank: 16)¹


