

# 1 in 31: The Long Reach of American Corrections West Virginia

### **POPULATION**

### 1 in 68 adults<sup>1,2</sup>

is under correctional control

- **Growth over time:** in 1982, the figure was 1 in 226 adults<sup>1,2</sup>
- Percent behind bars: at year end 2007, 48 percent of the correctional population was in prison or jail (national rank: 5); the figure for 1982 was 40 percent (national rank: 7)¹


spent on corrections

- Share of general fund: 4.7 percent in fiscal year 2008<sup>6</sup>
- Ratio of spending: For every dollar West Virginia spent on corrections in 2008, 6 cents went to probation<sup>5,6</sup>


