Two streams:

HIA & legal requirements

- May like to perform HIA
- Should perform HIA
- Must perform HIA
- Most countries are in group 1, but increasing number in group 2
- Very few countries are in group 3

Development of HIA

First...

- 'How to' guides and handbooks
- Learning by doing

Then...

- Quantitative methods, including costbenefit analysis
- Methods with a specific focus e.g. health inequalities, wellbeing
- Research work on settings, conditions, requirements: what makes HIA 'stick'?
- Health in other IA





HIA and decision making

- Project HIA, e.g. landfill site, regeneration scheme
 UK: better involvement of local communities, health is considered and project may be adapted.
- Policy level, a more fluid process. Difficult to identify contribution to better decisions.






