

# Program Evaluation: Results from 3 New HIA Programs

9 HIAs

- 70 formal and informal partnerships
- 8 Trainings
  - 173 professionals
  - Overall improvement in knowledge

# **HIA program recommendations**

- Enhance cross-agency collaboration and communication
- Take time to engage partners
- Utilize existing partnerships
- Choose HIAs carefully
- Build trust proactively
- Start early
- Offer a variety of training options
- Minimize staff turnover, maintain knowledge management
- Allow time for staff capacity building
