
is under correctional control

- **Growth over time:** in 1982, the figure was 1 in 90 adults^{1,2}
- Percent behind bars: at year end 2007, 29 percent of the correctional population was in prison or jail (national rank: 34); the figure for 1982 was 20 percent (national rank: 44)¹

TOTAL CORRECTIONAL POPULATION




COSTS

- Share of general fund: 4.3 percent in fiscal year 2008⁶
- Ratio of spending: For every dollar Hawaii spent on corrections in 2008, 4 cents went to probation and parole^{5,6}
