Dear Chair Murkowski, Chair Calvert, Ranking Member Udall, and Ranking Member McCollum:

As groups representing and supporting veterans and their families, we urge you to enact legislation to maintain and restore America's national park sites that commemorate the men and women who risked their lives to protect our freedom. Places like Valley Forge National Historical Park, Fort McHenry National Monument and Historic Shrine, Gettysburg National Military Park, World War II Valor in the Pacific National Monument, Korean War Veterans Memorial, and the Vietnam Veterans Memorial are iconic national parks that preserve our shared history.

About one-third of all national parks commemorates and interprets military history, including 25 battlefields and 14 national cemeteries. Some of these parks manage the decommissioned defensive structures, forts, and bases that once served to protect our country and where veterans trained; they now document this military history for future generations to learn from. All told, parks with military history assets have approximately \$6 billion in maintenance needs, about half of the overall estimated \$11.3 billion backlog for infrastructure repairs needed for the entire National Park System. Bipartisan legislation, the National Park Service Legacy Act (S. 751/H.R. 2584), would provide dedicated annual federal funding for national park deferred maintenance, including repairs devoted to military heritage. We strongly encourage its passage by Congress.

Places such as Vicksburg National Military Park, a final resting place for 17,000 Civil War Union soldiers, needs two million dollars to restore its cemetery. The Fort McHenry site, which interprets the Battle of Baltimore during the War of 1812 and served as inspiration for the "Star Spangled Banner," needs \$3.8 million in repairs. Park sites that commemorate 20th century wars also need infrastructure improvements, including the World War II Memorial in Washington, D.C., which has more than \$545,000 in deferred maintenance; the grounds at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial require a \$600,000 facelift; and Manzanar National Historic Site, one of ten camps where Japanese American citizens and resident Japanese aliens were incarcerated during World War II, has more than \$6.2 million in infrastructure needs.

Veterans stepped up when we needed them to protect and defend our country. Now it is time for Congress to honor their service by passing the National Park Service Legacy Act and ensuring that the sacrifices and stories of our veterans will not be forgotten.
