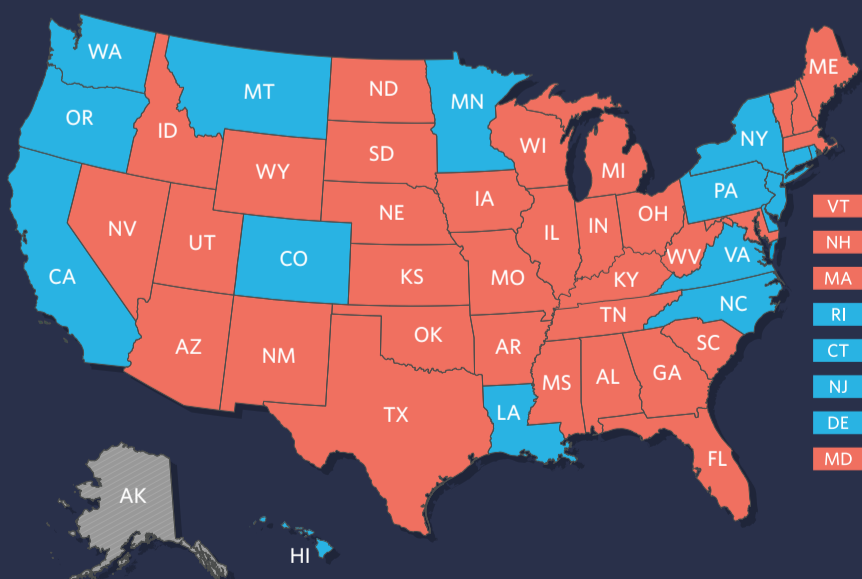

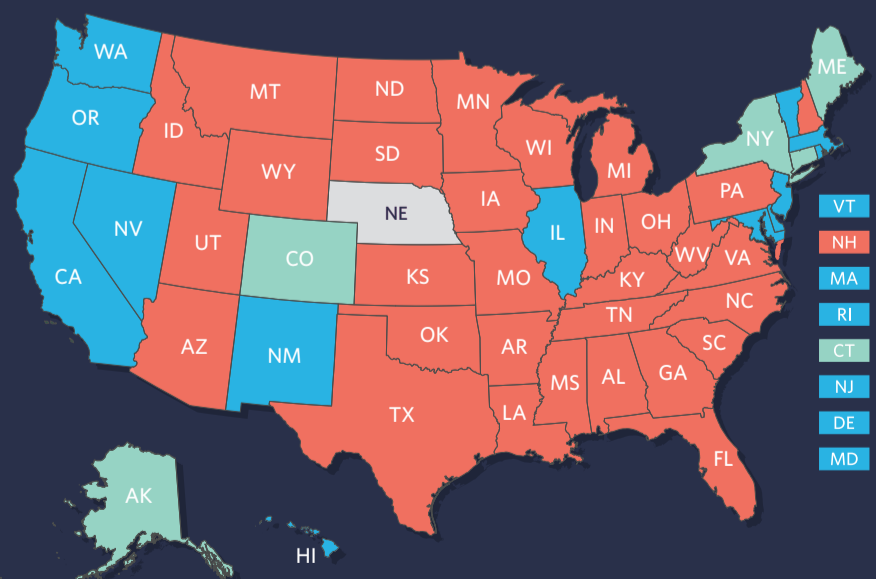
2018 Balance of Power
