

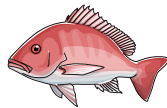


Older, Bigger Red Snapper Have More Offspring and Boost Species Recovery

Average reproduction, by fish age and size

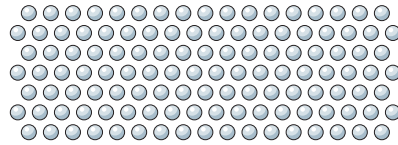
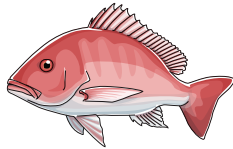
Age 2

3.2 million eggs



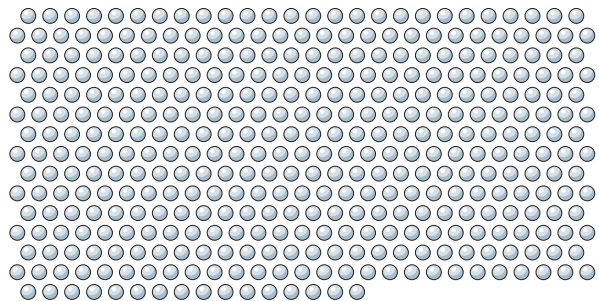
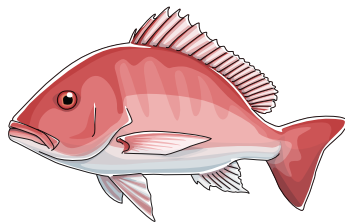
Age 6
