Conservation of Sharks in Europe is key

- EU is significant player in global catch, consumption and trade of shark products
- EU shark populations are in bad shape;
- EU policy is "exported" to regional and international forums
- EU still has no management plan for sharks
- EU (by derogation from finning ban) still allows removal of fins on board vessels



Conservation of Sharks Starts Here

- Portugal: second largest fleet in Europe!
- Portugal: one of five EU member states (out of 27) allowing the removal of fins from sharks on board vessels;
- Portugal is a shark fishing nation: shark conservation essential for future of fisheries;
- Portugal: presidency of EU can take leadership now!

Shark Alliance in Portugal

- Concerned conservation, scientific, diving organizations;
- Dedicated to science-based conservation of sharks;
- Raising awareness & public support for shark conservation;
- Increase reach to Portuguese NGOs;
- Aim: improve shark policy & status of shark populations in Europe and beyond.

Shark Alliance Primary Goals

- Secure & comprehensive EU shark fisheries management plan (including science-based limits & protection for depleted species); and
- Close loopholes in EU shark finning regulation to effectively stop practice & set better examples around the world.



Challenges and Opportunities

- Image of sharks as fierce hunters and their vulnerability;
- EU and Member States: Commission now working on shark management plan will member states support?
- Environment and Fisheries: Johannesburg agreement: Reverse loss of biodiversity by 2010!
